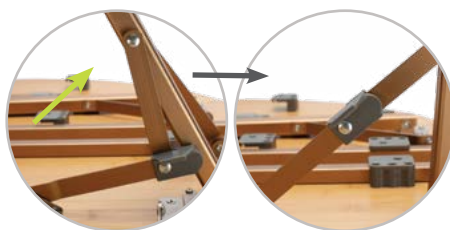

Engage the lock lever into the locked position.



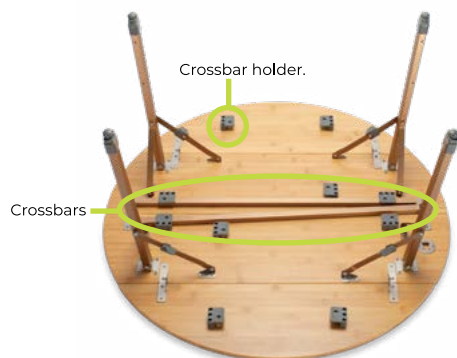

Remove the crossbars and turn 90°. Slot the crossbars into the support holders.



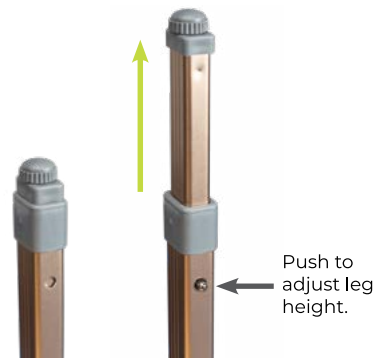

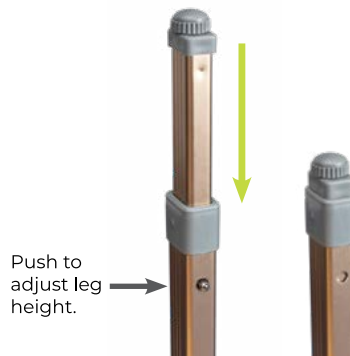




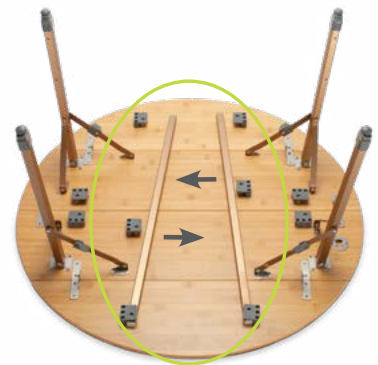
- 1** Turn the table upside down.



- 2** Push the button and collapse the legs in.



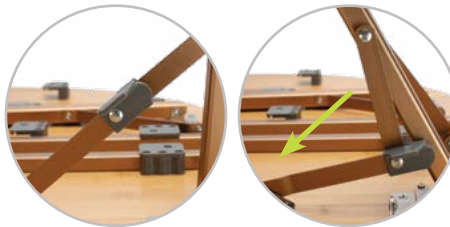
- 3** Slide the support poles off.



- 4** Turn the support poles 90° and place back in the holder.



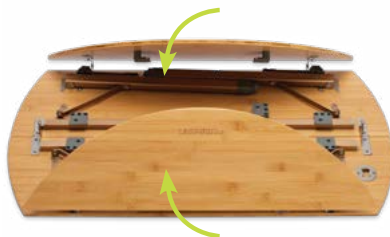
- 5** Disengage the lock lever into the close position.



- 6** Fold the legs down.
Note: ensure all legs are flat against the surface.

Care & Safety information:

- Be gentle with zips; always use two hands to close the zip; do not force it if zip gets caught.
- Do not use near open flame.
- Clean thoroughly after each use. Wash by hand with warm water and a soft towel or sponge.
- Do not use harsh cleaning chemicals.
- Leave the cupboard to dry out completely before putting it away.
- Do not keep the cupboard in direct sunlight or leave it in the rain.
- Store away from chemicals and moisture.
- In case re-coating is required; sand lightly with an extra fine-grit sandpaper. Reseal surface with a few coats of wood sealer product for ample water protection.
